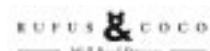
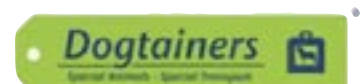

## OUR JUDGES

### ■ Kim Cutter (SACC)

I live in Cape Town, South Africa where I have had my own private Dental practice for 34 years. My involvement in The Cat Fancy spans some twenty five years during which I have served on various committees, currently the Chairman of Judges Council (SACC) and a Tutor Judge. I qualified as an All Breeds Judge in 2003 and have judged extensively locally, nationally and internationally (Australia and United Kingdom).

I am an animal lover and have always been "owned" by cats, dogs and horses. I have successfully breed quality Burmese for the past twenty years. The health and welfare of all animals but especially cats is my passion.



### ■ Wayne Trevathan (USA CFA)

Born in New Zealand and lived 1 year in England, 3 years in Sydney, 8 years in Canada where I did my University work at the University of Toronto in education, before moving to the USA in 1978. First exposed to cats when in Sydney, & took a Burmese with me to Canada. I became a judge with the Canadian Cat Association in 1976 and thereafter went to USA CFA where I was accepted as a judge in 1980 – that's 32 years behind the table! I have bred Burmese, Siamese & Persians and 18 years ago introduced the European Burmese to USA CFA with foundation stock coming primarily from Australia and Denmark. I have judged extensively in CFA and around the world for many different associations. I have sat on the CFA Board of Directors as Southern Regional Director from 1990 to 1998 and currently serve as a member of the CFA Judging Program Committee as administrator for all guest judging assignments and judging trainees from Japan and the International Division.



### ■ Deborah Cameron (NSW CFA)

I have been involved with the cat fancy for over 30 years having grown up in a family that bred and showed Persians. My love of cats grew and in the late 1980's I started showing and breeding Chinchilla, Shaded Silver and Golden Persians.

Dabbling with beautiful Smokes and Himalayans and my commitment by working at shows in various capacities such as Show Manager and Show Secretary, I felt that I needed even more involvement and I gained my Companion Judges license in 2003. Enjoying this new side of judging led to my long term goal in becoming a Group One Judge in 2005. Since then I have gained my Group 3 and Group 2 judging licences.

I hold the position of Secretary of the NSW Ku-Ring-Gai-Cat Club as well as being on the committee of various local clubs.

I work full time in Local Government managing a large team of Community Development Workers and enjoy the company of my cats and dog, Eddie.



### ■ Rhondda Watson (NSWCFA)

I am an All Breeds Tutor Judge and have helped with the training of many NSW and interstate Judges. I have judged throughout Australia and New Zealand where I have made many friends throughout the Cat Fancy. I enjoy my judging assignments and consider it a great privilege to be invited to judge and handle so many beautiful felines and such a variety of breeds in Australia & overseas.

I was President of the Siamese Cat Society for many years, resigning from that position in 1996 to become President of the Siamese & Shorthair Cat Club - a position I still currently hold. Other Clubs I support are the Abyssinian Cat Club, the Burmese Cat Club, the Oriental Cat Club and the Bengal Breed Club.

I have been a registered breeder since 1975. In 1984 I was elected to the Consultative Committee of RAS Cat Control and have served on that Committee and its successor, the NSWCFA Management Committee, continuously since then. During these 23 years of service I have been involved with fund-raising & was responsible for organizing Cat of the Year Luncheons and Champion of Champion dinners for many years. I have also been involved in training classes for Shorthair Judges, Domestic Judges and Stewards. I have been a delegate for CCCA meetings and have worked on the Breed Standards Committee and the Judges Training Committee. Currently I am Senior Vice President OF NSWCFA. My goal is to see a United Australian Cat Fancy where all the controls work together to promote the breeding and showing of our pedigreed cats.



### ■ Chris Buckley (NSWCFA)

Chris, a very experienced steward of many years standing, successfully completed the NSW C.F.A. Companion Judges Course in mid 2003. He and his partner, Brenda, own a tribe of Burmese, very successfully showing one of their pride and joy, Golden Oldie lilac spay CCCA Ch, GDGC & ACT TGC Rosepark Snowdrop. Both Chris and Brenda have been actively involved in the Burmese Cat Society of Australasia for many years. Currently Chris is serving as the Society's Burmese Show Manager.



### ■ Garry Stephens (NSWCFA)

I have been a Companion cat judge since 2000 and really enjoy judging this group. In 1983 I began showing two Burmese cats originally purchased as pets and in that year one of them Amaryllis Meggie won RAS Shorthair Spay Cat of the Year. So started my involvement in cat showing and breeding, and a little later show management and club administration. While I have specialized in Burmese and more recently in Maine Coons my experience as a steward since 1986 has given me a good appreciation of all breeds.

I firmly believe that good health and temperament are essential to making a good pet as well as a good show cat.





## SHOW HAPPENINGS

- ★ The Show will be a 3 ring Australian open style judging show for Burmese & Companion Cats & kittens.
- ★ You may elect to not enter an exhibit in one or more of the rings. Please mark this on your entry form for the exhibit concerned.
- ★ All exhibits will be benched in catalogue order, and judged from the same cage.  
**Coloured or white cage curtains may be used.**  
Again "own cages" may be used - **if you are to use an "own cage" for an exhibit PLEASE indicate this and it's size on the entry form.**
- ★ Litter kittens, entered in the age classes, will be judged from the litter cage, so you will not need to provide separate curtains.
- ★ **Top Burmese Exhibits:**  
Independently each ring judge will select and present their five (5) best exhibits
- ★ **Chocolate/Blue Colour Class (not tortie)**  
Eligible exhibits will be entered automatically. The Top 5 exhibits in each colour in this class will be awarded special prizes
- ★ **Top 3 Companion Exhibits in Show:**  
Independently each ring judge will select their five (5) best exhibits and place them in rank order. These rankings will be passed to the Show Secretary who will
  - total the rankings of each exhibit included, and
  - list the exhibits in order of total rank.
 The Top 3 Exhibits in this list will be the **Top 3 Companion Exhibits in Show.**
- ★ **Miscellaneous Classes**  
**For Burmese**, for each Miscellaneous Class
  - head type • eye colour & shape
  - coat colour & condition • purrsonality
 prizes will be awarded to the best kitten, best entire cat and best desexed cat.  
In addition the overall best exhibit in each class will be awarded a special Trophy.  
**For Companions**, for each Miscellaneous Class
  - most appealing face • best groomed
  - most appealing coat colour/markings
  - purrsonality
 prizes will be awarded to the best kitten and best cat.
- ★ **Kittens For Sale**  
An area for advertising your Burmese kittens for sale on the day will be available near the door in order to help potential buyers find you easily.
- ★ There will be several stalls for you to peruse.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ☐ An official NSW C.F.A. entry form must be completed and forwarded. [form on the back of the summary sheet]
- ☐ As indicated on the form, for each exhibit entered a legible copy of the exhibit's 4 generation pedigree, as issued by a controlling body recognised by CCCA or ACF, must be attached.

☐ **The summary sheet** which accompanies this schedule must be completed and forwarded also.

☐ An exhibitor resident in NSW must be a current financial member of NSW C.F.A. Inc. However

- A new exhibitor resident in NSW may show 3 times as a non-member provided any exhibit(s) shown is/are registered in the exhibitor's name with NSW C.F.A. Inc.

- An exhibitor resident in another state/territory/country must be a member of a controlling body recognised by CCCA or ACF in that state/territory/country and the exhibit(s) entered registered in the exhibitor's name with that controlling body.

☐ **Vaccination Requirements:**

Each kitten exhibit must have had at least one Feline 3 vaccination not less than 14 days prior to the Show.

Documentary evidence of vaccination must be produced to the veterinary officer. Failure to do so shall result in rejection of the exhibit concerned.

☐ All exhibits must have their front & back claws clipped

☐ **ONLY OZ-PET OR PAPER LITTER MAY BE USED**

☐ **All cats/kittens must remain on exhibition in show cages until 4.00 p.m. unless permission to leave early has been granted prior to the show by the Show Manager.**

☐ The Show Secretary reserves the right to transfer exhibits which are incorrectly entered.

☐ **Returned Cheques:** Should any cheque forwarded in payment be returned unpaid, a money order, a bank cheque, or cash will be required to be forwarded immediately to ensure acceptance of entry. Any costs incurred by the Society in such a circumstance shall be paid by the exhibitor before the entry is processed.

☐ Smoking is strictly prohibited inside the venue.

☐ **Cancellations** We ask for your co-operation in notifying the Show Secretary of cancellations before 12.00 noon Saturday 16th March (where possible).

☐ **Exhibitors are reminded:**

A Judge or Steward does not have to handle any exhibit showing signs of aggression. Owners have a duty of care not to bench exhibits with a reported history of fractious behaviour. Show Managers and the Show Committee, in consultation with the Show Representative, have the right to require the removal of the latter exhibits from the Show.

### Burmese Kittens/Litters Cage Areas

Both exhibitors and the public will not be permitted to enter the kittens/litters cage areas whilst any kitten judging is taking place. **This requirement will be strictly enforced.**
