## Our Activities

**Our annual Championship Specialist Burmese Show** is held usually in March each year. This show is open to all de-sexed and entire Burmese cats and Burmese kittens registered with a body recognised by the NSW CFA Inc.

**The Society's Website** contains a wealth of information about Burmese cats and the Society's activities. The Society's kitten register, a list of older Burmese seeking homes and a directory of breeder members are maintained on the site. It also gives progress results for the Members Cats/Kittens of the Year Awards.

**Burmese Bulletin**, the Society's Newsletter, is produced every 3 months, which serves to keep members fully informed about all Society activities. It contains brief articles of topical interest about the Burmese breed and showing, progress results for the Burmese Members Cat/Kitten of the Year Awards, and the results of Burmese exhibits in NSW CFA Shows.

**Tri monthly General Meetings.** Agendas and minutes of each general meeting are sent to all members. (Email is used to distribute the Bulletin and meeting agendas and minutes to those members with email, otherwise Australia post is used).

The Society honours the top **Burmese cats and Kittens of the Year** - entire and de-sexed, owned by its members, through its Members Cat/Kitten of the Year Awards.

The Society allocates money for **Cats in Distress** for Burmese cats and kittens which have "lost their way", either by being abandoned or having their owner become ill or passing away. The fund also helps with their rehabilitation and boarding until they are claimed or have found a new home.
